

## Web Bio for Lori Wood

The Board of Trustees appointed Lori Wood as Executive Director of the Fund, effective July 13, 2015, after an exhaustive search for a successor to Marc LeBlanc, who is retiring.

Ms. Wood has 24 years of experience working with benefit plans, plan sponsors and organized labor. She holds a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration. She began her career with the Service Employees International Union (SEIU) as a field auditor. After three years, she moved to the SEIU benefit plans. In 1999, she became the Administrative Director of Benefits where she managed multiple retirement plans and health plans. From 2002, through 2013, she served several senior management roles for SEIU and its funds, including Deputy Chief of Staff and Human Resources Manager.

Ms. Wood returns to benefit plan administration after a two-year stint at the Children's Defense Fund where she served as Vice President for Field and acting Chief Operating Officer.

Ms. Wood also holds CEBS and RPA designations from the International Foundation of Employee Benefit Plans.
